JA 重點	: 就業準備、企業精神、 理財知識、正面生活價值觀

1. 關於「JA Goal 青人生」工作坊

「JA Goal 青人生」工作坊是一個半天工作坊，旨在透過活動及商界義工的分享，向學生灌輸有關自我領導、計劃人生及負責任的理財方法等重要概念，為年青一代奠下基礎，助他們達成人生目標，成為對社會及個人財務負責任的未來領袖。

「JA Goal 青人生」工作坊會於星期六舉行，學生會分為 15-20 人小組，在三名商界義工帶領下，透過不同的活動、討論及商界義工分享，幫助學生更有效地計劃人生及實踐夢想。

工作坊會包含三個不同的活動：

一) 自我領導

工作坊會以一個互動形式的論壇作開始，由一位資深的行政人員主講，分享他的成功故事以及在定立個人目標、事業及個人財務計劃上的親身經驗，並鼓勵參與活動之學生向講者提問，促進交流。

二) 計劃人生

學生會以分組形式進行活動，在商界義工帶領下，為自己定立人生目標以及刻劃自己的人生旅圖。

三) 負責任的理財方法

商界義工分享在定立人生目標時，怎樣管理財富的個人經驗及專業理財知識，學生會透過活動去學習怎樣善用信貸，以達到個人需要及人生目標。

A) 協辦學校：

為半天的「JA Goal 青人生」工作坊提供場地，貴校就能：

- ✓ 豐富學生的「其他學習經歷」
 - 高達 30% 的名額可預留給 貴校學生，讓他們有機會參與，並從商界義工身上學習
 - 學生亦可擔當學生義工，協助工作坊的當日安排，從中得到社會服務經驗
- ✓ 獲 JA 於網頁及年報上表彰 貴校的支持

B) 參與學校：鼓勵及招募 貴校學生參加。

- 在校與學生進行**學生準備活動**

JA Goal for Youth Workshop

Target Students	: Form 4 to Form 7
Learning Time	: 5.5 hours
OLE Area	: Career-Related Experiences, Moral and Civic Education
JA Focus	: Work-Readiness, Entrepreneurship, Financial Literacy, Essential Life-wide Values

1. About JA Goal for Youth

The **JA Goal for Youth** is a half-day program aimed at equipping senior secondary students with essential concepts on personal leadership, life planning and financial responsibility – the fundamentals for our next generation to achieve their goals and to become socially and financially responsible leaders of tomorrow.

The JA Goal for Youth Workshop will be held on Saturday. Three business volunteers will lead a group of 15-20 students through the workshop and share their real-life experiences with the students. Students will learn through interactive forum and hands-on activities that empower them to plan their future and realize their dreams.

Three steps in mapping the future to be covered in the workshop include:

A) Personal Leadership

The workshop will be kick-started by an interactive forum featuring an inspirational speech by experienced executive. He or she will share the success stories and valuable experiences on personal goal setting, career and financial planning. All participating students will be encouraged to raise questions on areas that they are keen to know as they are planning their way forward.

B) Life Planning

Students will break out into groups, and be led by business volunteers in setting their personal life goals and drawing their life maps.

C) Financial Responsibility

Business volunteers will share their expertise and professional knowledge with the students on how to achieve their life goal by managing their wealth, in both talent and financial terms. Through hands-on activities, students will practice making decisions about when and how credit should be used wisely accordingly to the personal need.

2. Application Procedure

Your school may participate in the JA Goal for Youth Workshop in two ways:

A) HOST School: Provide the venue for JA Goal for Youth Workshop for more students of your school and schools in the district to be able to benefit.

By providing the venue for the half-day JA Goal for Youth Workshop, your school will:

- ✓ Enrich your students' OLE
 - Up to 30% of places can be reserved for your students to participate in the workshop and learn directly from experienced business professionals
 - Students will have the community service opportunity to support the workshop as student volunteers
- ✓ Be recognized as a JA Supporter at JA website and annual report

B) PARTICIPATING School: Encourage and recruit students from your school to participate in the JA Goal for Youth Workshop.

3. Resources Commitment

Your school will need to:

- Encourage and recruit **Form 4 to Form 7 students** to participate
- Nominate a **Link Teacher** to coordinate the program with JA, attend a 1-hour briefing organized by JA, and conduct a 1-hour Preparation Session for the students.
- Conduct **1-hour Learning Preparation Session** with participating students prior to the workshop
- * Arrange the **school hall (with microphone and projector, tables and chairs) and 20 classrooms** for use at the workshop

** for host schools only*

JA will provide:

- All program materials** for students (including student workbooks and all activity materials).
- Business Volunteers** to guide students through the program
- 1-hour briefing** session to familiarize Link Teachers and Business Volunteers with the program
- JA Staff** to coordinate and support the program
