Introduction

Students often have to make crucial decisions on their education and career paths without understanding what a particular profession is all about. JA Career Talk and Job Shadowing enable students to understand the opportunities and requirements of a specific industry sector/profession and to have a taste of the real workplace.

Program Highlights

Students (around 15) interested in learning more about an organisation/profession will have an opportunity to shadow a mentor at work for a full day. Before the shadowing, teachers lead a session to prepare the students for the experience and follow up the shadowing with a reinforcement session.
