
Introduction

Net's Be Wise aims to empower children aged 8-12 to acquire 8 digital citizenship competencies, enabling them to make discerning and deliberate choices that maximize the benefits of technology while mitigating cyber risks. The program incorporates the internationally recognized and research backed DQ World online learning platform and offline school workshops, and offers opportunity for schools to assess students' Digital Intelligence (DQ™). The program can be incorporated in the General Studies Curriculum for Primary Students.
