Introduction

Session 3: Organizational Ethics

Through case studies, explore professional duties and ethical conflicts within various departments in a business.





Session 2: Employee Ethics

Recognize ethical requirements for employees at workplaces.





Session 4: Global Business Ethics

Through role-play, explore complex ethical issues found in global business.









Job Shadowing Opportunity

Selected students who have completed the workshop will be invited to sign up for the extended learning activity **One-Day Job Shadowing @ ExxonMobil Hong Kong (EMHK)**. The experience provides opportunities for students to shadow EMHK workplace mentor to understand how business ethics are applied in the workplace and daily operations.

Students are required to complete the preprogram readings provided by JA so as to familiarize themselves with the following topics before the actual workshop:

- Common Fallacies
- Social Responsibility, ESG requirements and Corporate Sustainability
